This psychological 'exhaustion' is long-term work pressure and has a widespread impact, with increased turnover, reduction in job satisfaction and decrease in productivity (Maricuțoiu et al., 2016). The World Health Organization estimates that the cost of the workplace burnout costs around \$ 1.5 trillion, which is annual due to lost productivity (Bianchi and Shonfeld, 2023), which highlights the immediate need for effective prevention strategies. 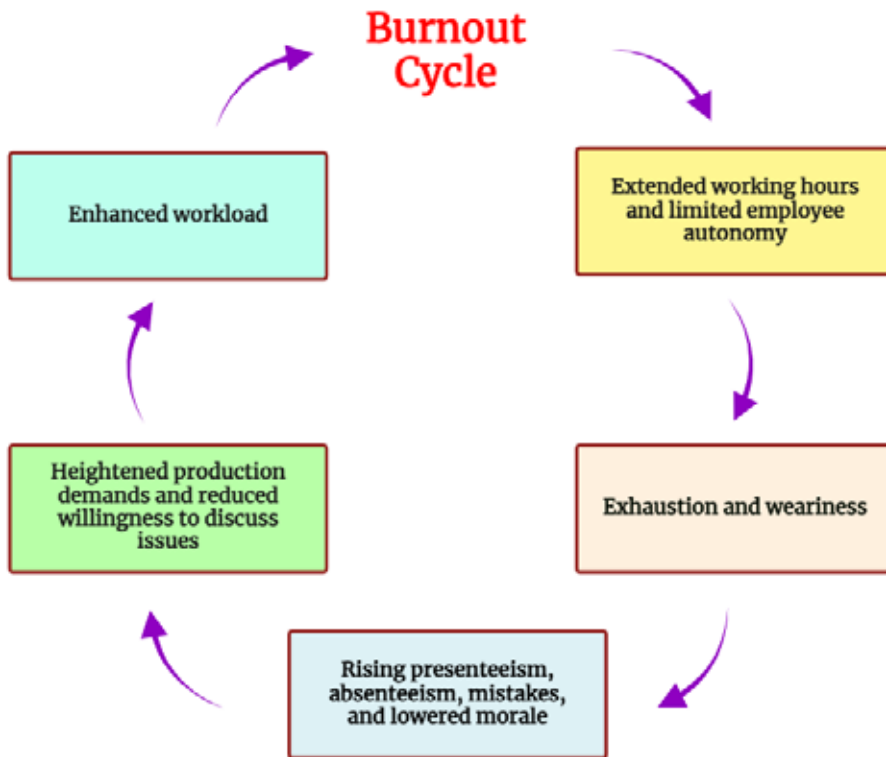

Beyond personal results, burnouts can lead to old health issues, such as fatigue, anxiety and depression, managers and policy makers to consider the burnout as an important organizational concern rather than just an HR issue. Employee assistance programs, flexible work system and reducing mental health stigma are essential steps towards addressing this crisis (Amsrud et al., 2019).
